

For admission of students in the field

- A bachelor's degree (KKM Level 6) in the field of Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL)/ Linguistics/ Language Studies, or in other related fields with minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.50 as recognized by the University Senate; or
- ii. A bachelor's degree (KKM Level 6) in the field of Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL)/ Linguistics/ Language Studies, or in other related fields, but not achieving Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.50 is subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in related field; or
- iii. Any other qualifications recognized by the Government of Malaysia.
- iv. The international students are required to achieve a minimum score of band 6.0 for the English Language Testing System (IELTS) or a score of 550 for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or level B2 for examinations aligned with CEFR or equivalent and accepted by the Government of Malaysia
